By linking multiple voice processing systems into a single network, ActiveNet shatters the messaging barrier between offices. Users can communicate just as easily with people in the next office as the next continent.

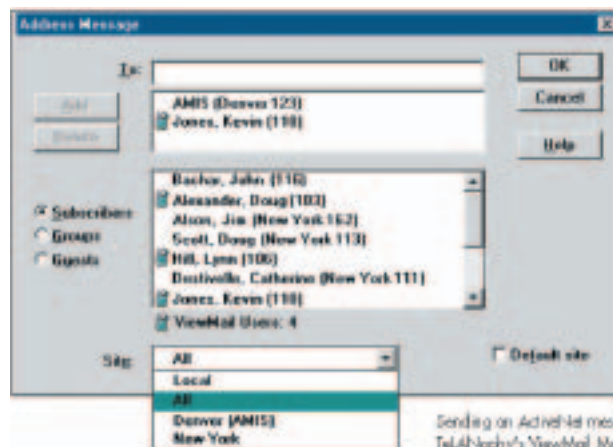
Efficient Universal Messaging

ActiveNet's powerful features are designed to save users time and enhance their productivity. By making multi-site messaging a viable solution, ActiveNet provides

an affordable, easy-to-use communications link between your mail office and networked voice mail systems all over the world. Instead of playing telephone tag with people in other time zones, ActiveNet users simply leave a touchtone-driven voice mail message. Information is transmitted clearly and concisely 24-hours a day.

Because ActiveNet is also designed to promote cost-efficiency, items that require immediate attention can be marked urgent for instant transmission. Non-urgent messages are collected by the NEAXMail IM-16 system and sent in groups when long-distance rates are lowest or at any other scheduled time. Messages can be marked private to ensure confidentiality and users can request a return receipt to verify delivery.

ActiveNet users can also control remote messages from their PCs with the optional TeLANophy® ViewMail® module. ViewMail shows all subscribers from networked NEAXMail IM-16 systems on one screen and lets you send messages to any of them with a few mouse clicks.

System Requirements

ActiveNet's PlusNet protocol requires current NEAXMail IM-16 software. ActiveNet systems using the AMIS protocol can communicate with any AMIS-compliant voice processing system.

To control costs, each subscriber's access to remote subscribers and groups is supervised by the system manager.

PlusNet™ Networking

When multiple NEAXMail IM-16 systems are linked together, ActiveNet uses the

PlusNet protocol to provide enhanced networking capabilities. PlusNet adds many advanced features that are important for clear, secure communications.

These include urgent and private messages, unlimited number of messages per call, unlimited number of recipients per message and unlimited message length. PlusNet also provides time stamps, return receipts and message announcements using the sender's voice name.

PlusNet's group messaging capabilities let subscribers contact several people at once. Groups can contain subscribers from both local and remote sites.

PlusNet makes many of NEAXMail IM-16's powerful subscriber-to-subscriber messaging features available for remote sites. Remote messages can be cancelled, re-recorded or updated until they are transmitted, and messages from remote subscribers are announced with a recorded voice name.

PlusNet also minimizes system maintenance by running auto-

matic directory updates. When you add or change subscribers on one system, all other sites are changed automatically.

Reduced Costs

ActiveNet not only improves messaging, it also reduces communications costs. Instead of dialing long-distance during business hours, users can leave messages for people at remote sites at any time. Non-urgent messages are delivered when rates are low, significantly reducing communications costs.

By linking your NEAXMail IM-16 to the rest of the world, ActiveNet expands the boundaries of your communications system and your business.
